
West Nile Encephalitis

Start Now!

- Mosquitoes, the transmitters of the West Nile virus, can breed in any puddle of water.
- Landscape your property to reduce low spots.
- Remove anything from outside that holds water.
- Check storm drains, leaky faucets and window wells.
- Clean and chlorinate all pools as needed.

- Don't allow water to stagnate in birdbaths, pools or ponds.
- Clean clogged roof gutters and spouting every year.
- Aerate ornamental pools and/or stock with fish.
